

MINUTES REGULAR COUNCIL
REYNOLDSBURG CITY COUNCIL
September 9, 2002

President of Council Bradley L. McCloud called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Members of Council present: Mel Clemens, William L. Hills, Lane J. Beougher, Ron Stake, Sarah Cannella, Jim Wade, Eric Gilbert.

The Invocation was given by Mr. Beougher. Mr. McCloud led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of regular Council meeting held July 22, 2002 were approved without objection.

The agenda was approved.

Community Comments and Requests- -Donna Clifford, 256 Estates Lane, spoke on pedestrian safety in the areas of 1284 Brice Road and also Windriver Drive. She asked for signs to be posted for the Tomato Festival and July 4th activities directing traffic to Civic Park from Windriver Drive. She asked for paving there also. She asked that the City pave the K-Mart parking lot because she injured her ankle there. She asked permission from the Mayor to present a speech on September 11th for remembrance of the bombings of the World Trade Center.

Mr. Mussi informed Council that Mayor McPherson was at Civic Park at a ceremony for the bikers from Torches Across America honoring the deceased members of the World Trade Center, The Pentagon, and the crash of the aircraft in western Pennsylvania. He said after that event, they would go to the Whitehorse, and would like to invite Council members and everyone to attend.

Clerk read report from Clerk of Courts: monies collected from courts held during July, 2002 - \$24,086.20.
