

MINUTES REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
REYNOLDSBURG CITY COUNCIL  
JUNE 28, 2004

President of Council William L. Hills called the meeting to order at 7:33 p.m.

Members of Council present: Ron Stake, Preston Stearns, Brett Baxter, Mel Clemens, Antoinette Newman, Lane J. Beougher. Councilman Eric Gilbert was absent.

The Invocation was given by Mr. Beougher. Mr. Hills led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the regular Council meeting held June 14, 2004 were approved without objection.

The agenda was approved.

Community Comments and Requests- -Ms. Paula Brooks was present, and stated that she was present to listen and learn about Reynoldsburg. Ms. Brooks said she just finished eight years on the Upper Arlington City Council; and thanked Reynoldsburg City Council for their public service, and Mayor McPherson for his service.

Communications- -Mr. Hills stated that the Clerk of Council had received a fax with two letters attached that had been distributed to all members of Council and the Administration; that it was an Administrative matter; that the documents would be on file in the Clerk's office.

Reports- -Mr. Clemens stated that in one of the newspapers, there was an article about pay increases for employees, and it mentioned that the city had paid Clemans, Nelson to upgrade the policies and pay grades for the employees. He said that Clemans, Nelson was *not* Mel Clemens and Bob Nelson!
