

MINUTES REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
REYNOLDSBURG CITY COUNCIL  
JUNE 12, 2006

President of Council William L. Hills called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Members of Council present: Mel Clemens, Antoinette Newman, Donna Shirey, Ron Stake, Preston Stearns, Brett Baxter, Doug Joseph.

The Invocation was given by Mr. Stearns. Mr. Hills led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the regular Council meeting held May 22, 2006 were approved without objection.

The agenda was approved.

Community Comments and Requests- -Ms. Delores Trivett, 10371 Taylor Road complimented the city about how nice Main Street looks.

Communications- -Clerk read report from Clerk of Courts: total monies collected from courts held during May 2006 - \$30,612.55. Monies also collected during that period pursuant to Ordinance Nos. 146-94 and 104-02- -\$1,858 for the Computerization Needs Fund, and \$225 for the Enforcement and Education Fund.

Reports- -Janet Walker, President of Marabar Heights Garden Club, presented a check to Paul Walsh, Parks and Recreation Director, in the amount of \$750 to help pay for the hanging baskets in Olde Reynoldsburg. Mr. Walsh thanked Ms. Walker and the Club, noting they had supported the department's efforts for several years. Mr. Walsh also thanked Horticulturist Delayne Williams for her work.

Clerk read motion: That the Mayoral appointments of the Tax Administrator as representative, and the City Auditor as alternate, to the Regional Council of Governments is hereby approved. Mr. Stake moved adoption. Mrs. Newman seconded. All voted "Aye". Motion passed.

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT FOR 2006 FIREWORKS DISPLAY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY- -Clerk read ordinance by title for the one required reading. Mr. Stake said there had been a question in committee about the City Attorney's approval of the contract still being needed; that he had spoken with the City Attorney, who said the contract was fine. Mr. Stake moved adoption. Mr. Baxter seconded. With the roll called, members voted: Mr. Clemens "Yea"; Mrs. Newman "Yea"; Mrs. Shirey "Yea"; Mr. Stake "Yea"; Mr. Stearns "Yea"; Mr. Baxter "Yea"; Mr. Joseph "Yea". Motion passed; Ordinance No. 46-06 adopted.

Mr. Clemens moved adoption. Mr. Joseph seconded. With the roll called, members voted: Mr. Clemens "Yea"; Mrs. Newman "Yea"; Mrs. Shirey "Yea"; Mr. Stake "Yea"; Mr. Stearns "Yea"; Mr. Baxter "Yea"; Mr. Joseph "Yea". Motion passed;

Ordinance No. 47-06 adopted.

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT FOR WATER IMPROVEMENT NO. 831 TAYLOR ROAD 12" WATER MAIN EXTENSION PHASE 1 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY- - Clerk read ordinance by title for the one required reading. Mr. Clemens moved to amend the ordinance by adding "APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE" in the title inserted before "AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY"; and changing the appropriation wording in Section 2 by removing "monies are available in account no. 410.098.5651 (proceeds from Bond Issuance and Sale - \$1,800,000)" and inserting "AN AMOUNT OF \$117,500 IN THE UNAPPROPRIATED WATER FUND BE AND IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED TO ACCOUNT NO. 710.097.5621". Mr. Stake seconded. All voted "Aye". Motion passed; Ordinance amended. Mr. Clemens moved adoption. Mr. Stearns seconded. With the roll called, members voted: Mr. Clemens "Yea"; Mrs. Newman "Yea"; Mrs. Shirey "Yea"; Mr. Stake "Yea"; Mr. Stearns "Yea"; Mr. Baxter "Yea"; Mr. Joseph "Yea". Motion passed; Ordinance No. 48-06 adopted.

RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE TAX BUDGET OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2007 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY- - Clerk read resolution by title for the first reading. Mr. Hills set a Public Hearing for June 26, 2006 at 7:15 p.m. in Council Chambers.

ORDINANCE APPROVING THE NAMING OF SIX ALLEYS (Buckeye Alley, Hickory Alley, Elm Alley, Ash Alley, Maple Alley, and Cherry Alley); AND REPEALING AND REPLACING ORDINANCE NO. 19-06 PASSED MARCH 13, 2006- - Clerk read ordinance by title for the second reading. Mr. Baxter moved suspension of the CRC Section 4.04 three reading rule. Mr. Joseph seconded. With the roll called, members voted: Mr. Clemens "Yea"; Mrs. Newman "Yea"; Mrs. Shirey "Yea"; Mr. Stake "Yea"; Mr. Stearns "Yea"; Mr. Baxter "Yea"; Mr. Joseph "Yea". Motion passed; rule suspended. Mr. Baxter moved adoption. Mrs. Shirey seconded. Mrs. Newman seconded. With the roll called, members voted: Mr. Clemens "Yea"; Mrs. Newman "Yea"; Mrs. Shirey "Yea"; Mr. Stake "Yea"; Mr. Stearns "Yea"; Mr. Baxter "Yea"; Mr. Joseph "Yea". Motion passed; Ordinance No. 50-06 adopted.
