

MINUTES REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
REYNOLDSBURG CITY COUNCIL  
April 25, 2011

President of Council William L. Hills called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Members of Council present: Chris Long, Nathan Burd, Fred Deskins, Jr., Leslie Kelly, Doug Joseph, Mel Clemens, Barth R. Cotner.

The Invocation was given by Mr. Hills, who also led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the regular Council meeting held April 11, 2011 were approved without objection.

The agenda was approved, with Mr. Hills noting Council had received a letter in the packets from the Reynoldsburg Police Department indicating that the liquor permit request for Odd Lots, was for sealed beverage, beer/wine, and whatever low spirit bottles there are; there had been a question as to what the requested classifications were, and since the answer had been received, the Clerk could return the request without a request for a hearing.

Clerk read report from Clerk of Court - -total monies collected from courts held during March, 2011 - \$69,076.80. Total monies also collected during that same period pursuant to Ordinance Numbers 146-94 and 104-02- - \$4,735 for the Computerization Needs Fund; and \$75 for the Enforcement and Education Fund.

Clerk read Motion: That Reynoldsburg City Council does hereby authorize CT Consultants to provide plan review and site inspection services for private site improvements, in accordance with the proposal dated March 25, 2011- -Mr. Deskins moved adoption; Mr. Joseph seconded. With the roll called, members voted: Mr. Long "Yea"; Mr. Burd "Yea"; Mr. Deskins "Yea"; Mrs. Kelly "Yea"; Mr. Joseph "Yea"; Mr. Clemens "Yea"; Mr. Cotner "Yea". Motion passed; Ordinance No. 16-11 adopted.
