ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO PURCHASE ONE (1) POLICE CRUISER AND RELATED EQUIPMENT FOR THE REYNOLDSBURG POLICE DEPARTMENT; APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. --- Clemens. Public Safety, Law and Courts Committee.

Chief Plesich: This is the request to purchase Ford Interceptor for a replacement for car 279 that was totaled in a crash about 6 weeks ago. The City's insurance company has issued a check in the amount of \$29,349.00 which was deposited into the general fund. We're asking for that to be appropriated to our account. In addition we're asking for an additional appropriation in the general amount of \$5,443.90. This covers the cost in the difference of the vehicles and the installation and equipment which Council Woman Bryant had asked about 2 weeks ago. That's specific cost should be in the range of \$4949.00. And with a 10% overage for other cost, that brings it \$5443.90, the difference are made up from the new vehicle purchase price subtracting the settlement plus the cost the wiring, installation, markings and decals, paint work and radio installation.

Ms. Bryant: I was wondering if maybe you could tell us a little more about the accident that happened for this to be totaled.

Chief Plesich: One of our officers was operating marked cruiser number 279, he was distracted and struck a vehicle that was in the roadway as part of a prior crash.

Ms. Bryant: Ok.

Mr. Spalding: Were there any injuries involved in that crash?

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Chief Plesich: I believe that the injuries that were sustained were from the first crash but I'm not positive, I'll have to get back to you on that.
