ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CITY AUDITOR TO REMOVE EQUIPMENT FROM THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET LIST; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. --- Clemens. Public Safety, Law and Courts Committee.

Chief Plesich: Good Evening President Joseph, members of Council. April, is this the two items, the projector and the weight equipment or is this the cruiser? One of them is for emergency and the other is not. Ok, thank you. This is for equipment no longer operational or not fitting the needs of the department. Requesting permission to remove a Toshiba projector and some commercial weight equipment from our weight room.

Mr. Clemens: Are there any questions for the chief pertaining to this item? You say that's weight equipment?

Chief Plesich: There was a broken leg press type machine.

Chief Plesich: Thank you for reconvening. It is important that we also remove this piece of equipment which is a 2018 Ford Interceptor which has been deemed totaled out of a traffic crash by Trident, our city's insurance carrier so we're asking for the insurance payment in the amount of \$29,349.00 and to do that we need to return that car to the insurance company.

Ms. Bryant: So this was totaled at \$29,300 basically, are you also asking for a replacement vehicle or is that to come? What do you anticipate?

Chief Plesich: Sometimes collisions result in a totalling that may not look that way, it took a couple weeks to make that determination.

Ms. Bryant: Ok.

Mr. Clemens: What year was that?

Chief Plesich: That was a 2018.

Mr. Clemens: How much did we pay for it 80 some thousand all together?

Chief Plesich: Well those numbers, when you see those high numbers, that includes all of the equipment.

Mr. Clemens: Yeah, did we save the equipment?

Chief Plesich: We are going to salvage every piece of equipment out of there we can and we anticipate that will be almost all of it.

Ms. Bryant: So we're going to be losing out a fair amount then. Because to replace the vehicle, I think the last time you were looking for a vehicle you were looking to replace was around \$36-37,000.

Chief Plesich: There is definitely, when you drive a car off the lot, you get that depreciation, so we'll lose that depreciation, how ever long we had that car, about 6 months. It costs us money when we wreck cars.
