AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE, ADOPT AND ENACT A SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO --- Cotner. Finance and Administration Committee.

Mrs. Beggerow: This item comes to you from section 4.13 of the charter, that discusses the codification process. Essentially, as we do ordinances that effect our code in the City, I send them to American Legal and they update them online. At the end of the year, American Legal will go through and take all of the changes at the state level and incorporate them into the code which brings us to this point here. This has been advertised in the paper and we just ask to approve the new code supplement.

Mr. Cotner: And this is something that were staying up on now, where we kind of been lagging before?

Mrs. Beggerow: Yes. All the things that we pass here pertaining to the City are done as soon as we pass them and they are signed and enacted, they are posted online.

Mr. Hood: The only thing that I would add, is what you said at the end. This was something that we have been a little lax in the past with. April is now on a schedule with our codifiers. We do it much more often which makes it less cumbersome when we go through so after April gets the proposed changed after you have ordained them before they go in the book, they come to my office for a second review before it comes to you to make sure what you actually did is what's going in the book to be archived and codified as our new laws. As you all know, the majority of work you do legislatively are uncodified ordinances, that don't need to go into our codified ordinances, when we

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go look to find those laws. They just are kept in our Council office. They day to day business that you guys generally do. But since she has had us on schedule, its been much easier to work with, our codifiers are great, they do a good job, they are very few errors if any we find. There is a few more pages to go through but we will be set before this things goes into law.
