The responses to these questions will form the basis of a low-key, nominal group consensus building exercise. This exercise is not a master planning activity. This process tends to eliminate the "squeaky wheel" and generates a consensus among participants. The results are not statistically significant, only a list of future activities and a general direction to pursue. The result of this exercise does not address the question of how the selected goals should be accomplished can be outlined by working with the Mayor and staff.
