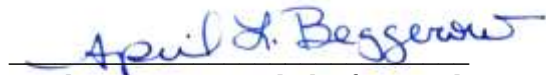

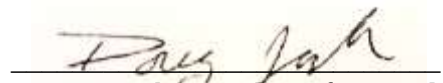
Mr. Spalding: Thank you Mel.
